



The journey continues through a side-lit corridor, past a delicate steel sculptural screen, and finally, into the open-plan living area where a radiant burst of light and air unfurls. Beyond this, discover a lush, wooded alley that beckons.

Choreographed with precision, the house's design masterfully delays the unveiling of the double-height outdoor living space, culminating in a grand reveal. This dramatic contrast, reminiscent of a musical composition building from a soft beginning to a vibrant crescendo, elevates the experience. The dance of light through the concrete brise-soleil further enhances the ambiance. This architectural masterpiece extends beyond a sparkling green swimming pool to a terrain that dramatically descends into a verdant valley – a rare vestige of the rainforest.


